This helps the students to grow an ability to analyze various aspects according to their own perspectives. Thus the educational thought of Rabindra Nath as well as Open learning system gives importance to the learning experience of the learners. Prof Ghosh encouraged the learners to follow the instructions of the university rhrough the website and visit the e -repositories of NSOU for self learning and enjoy a great learning experience though this unique system.



Dr. Uttam Dutta, Professor of Commerce, opined that a large number of people in today's generation have stopped reading good books and they no more have the inclination to listen to traditional music. He said that Gurudev played a very important role in shaping our lives. Tagore according to Prof Duta was a versatile composer and he had composed more than 2000 songs, which is unbelievable. He has written songs and poetries for every emotions, moods and

even seasons. Kavi guru gives us reasons to laugh, cry and even exhibit anger. His poems, songs, dramas and essay give an optimistic feeling and are very much related to the lives of common people. It will not be wrong to say that we may get remedies to our problems if we deeply read Tagore's work.
